'Ride For Daniel' on the Sunshine Coast

Long distance Kawasaki rider and 2009 Iron Butt Rally entrant, David 'Davo' Jones and his Kawasaki 1400GTR motorcycle named 'Roku', joined over 7000 riders for the 4th Ride For Daniel on QLD's Sunshine Coast on Sunday 8th June.

Ride For Daniel, a 110 kilometre ride, started at Nambour's Big Pineapple and continued past the memorial for Daniel Morcombe, the Sunshine Coast teenager abducted while waiting for a bus on 7 December 2003. The ride then snaked through the Sunshine Coast Hinterland before finishing at the Ettamogah Pub. Davo joined thousands of other participants to raise awareness for missing Daniel Morcombe and to send a message that abuse against children is not acceptable. All money raised goes to the Daniel Morcombe Foundation.



Long distance Kawasaki rider, Davo, is president/founder of the FarRiders Club and has been busy making a name for himself of late, zigzagging across the country on board his Kawasaki 1400GTR motorcycle, Roku. Davo has been clocking up thousands and thousands of kilometres on Roku in preparation for the Holy Grail of long distance motorcycle riding, the Iron Butt Rally. Davo has been accepted to take part in the 2009 Iron Butt Rally in the United States. The Iron Butt Rally is a gruelling 11,000 miles in 11 days motorcycle rally run every second year across the USA. Davo will proudly fly the flag for Kawasaki Australia at the event on board his 1400GTR.



Davo was happy to take part in Sunday's Ride For Daniel, saying, "I was proud to take part in such a well organised event that raised a good amount of money for an extremely worthwhile cause."
